DESCRIPTION

Originally purpose built as a junior/primary school in the South Pembrokeshire town of Pembroke Dock, the premises are made up of a variety of former classrooms, hall, corridors, offices, staff room, WC facilities etc. In all the buildings extend to a floor space which we are informed is approximately 9,510 sq ft (883.88 sq m) on a securely fenced site of approximately 1.32 acres (0.534 hectares). While the premises have formerly been used as a school, there is the opportunity of conversion for other uses as well as complete redevelopment subject to any planning consents that may be necessary.

LOCATION

The premises are located in Pembroke Dock which is one of the larger settlements in the south west of the county of Pembrokeshire. It was formerly the home of the Royal Naval Dockyard and is currently well known for its ferry port serving Ireland. The town also serves the nearby power station, oil terminal and LNG plants. The premises are located in one of the quieter areas of the town with easy access both into the town centre and also to the main road system via Pembroke Road and Ferry Lane.

The premises are available Freehold with vacant possession.
