Velcome to The Victorian House. Step up the short flight of steps and through your elegant panelled and glazed front door set beneath a traditional over-light and enter the handsome hall. Original stripped wood flooring guides you up to the fine period staircase.







With high-end entertaining at home becoming more popular, The Victorian House has the ultimate in luxury entertaining spaces accessed directly off the dining room. Sleek bespoke kitchen cabinets work in harmony with the home's historic architecture and are serenely decorated using a neutral palette which compliments the contemporary appliances and modern day conveniences required for a busy family life. From here, one door accesses the utility/boot room, with a further door leading out to the side of the property.
