Partially tiled with a wash hand basin, High flush WC and shower cubicle. Space for a washing machine and a tumble dryer. Double-glazed obscured window to the rear.

Feature fireplace and wood laminate flooring. Door to the inner lobby. Leads into the kitchen.

Partially tiled, fitted kitchen, with a mix of wall and base units with work surface over, butler sink, cooker hood and space for a cooker. Space for a fridge/freezer. Double-glazed windows to the rear and side.

Door leading out to the garden and door to the cellar.

Cellar

Storage space.

First Floor Landing

Stairs from the ground floor and feature glazed window to the rear. Doors to all bedrooms and the bathroom.

Bedroom One

Radiator and double-glazed window to the rear.

Bedroom Two

Radiator, exposed wood flooring and double-glazed window to the rear.

Bedroom Three

Built-in storage cupboard, feature fireplace, radiator and double-glazed window to the front.

Bathroom

Wash hand basin, high flush WC and a bath. Radiator and double-glazed obscured window to the rear.





Outside Rear Garden

A mature and well-established garden with a variety of flower and shrubs. Lawn area and a patio area. Greenhouse and sheds.

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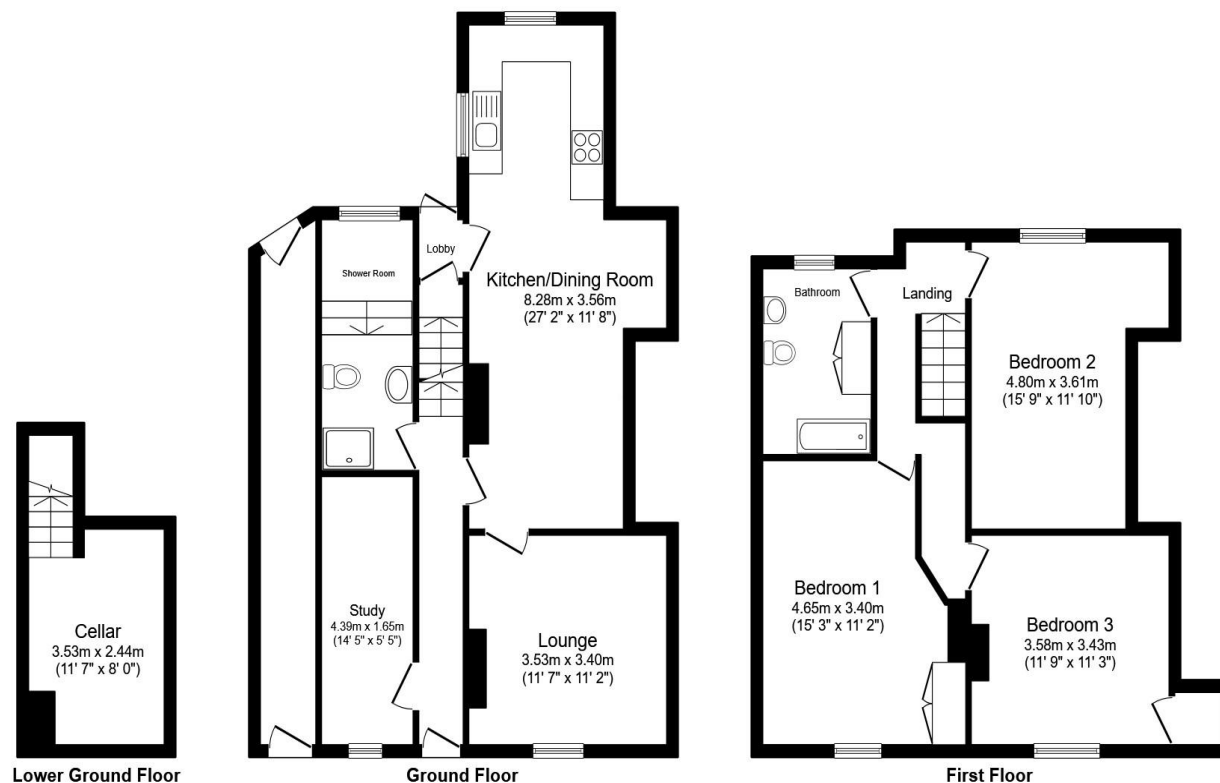
